## Resolution for Endorsement of H.R. 3599, DIGNIDAD, Dignity Act of 2023 Bill

WHEREAS, LULAC Council #2 whole-heartedly supports a reasonable immigration policy and

WHEREAS, Representatives Veronica Escobar (TX-16) and María Elvira Salazar (FL-27) have introduced the Dignity Act if 2023, a historic, bipartisan immigration reform bill, numerous Republicans and Democrats have signed on to the bill; and

WHEREAS, the bill addresses border security and infrastructure, creates legal status for undocumented immigrants already living in the United States with the possibility of earning citizenship, establishes new pathways for asylum seekers, and creates new legal pathways for economic migrants and unaccompanied minors; and

WHEREAS, this comprehensive bill makes meaningful reforms to several aspects of our immigration system

- It grants additional pathways to citizenship, including through the new dignity program, certified agricultural worker status, or service through the armed forces;
- It grants legal status to undocumented immigrants already living in the United States with the possibility of earing citizenship;
- It establishes new pathways for asylum seekers and creates new regional processing centers;
- It creates new legal pathways for economic migrants and unaccompanied minors; and

BE IT RESOLVED, LULAC whole-heartedly endorses passage of the Dignity Act of 2023 Bill, encourages Congressional members to sign on to the bill and pass as soon as possible
