

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:

WHAT TO DO IF IMMIGRATION OR THE POLICE STOP YOU OUTDOORS



REMAIN SILENT

If asked, you should give your name. But you still have the right to remain silent about everything else. Immigration can use anything you say against you.



STAY CALM AND DO NOT RUN

Use your phone to take photos and notes about the stop, but stay calm and do not run.



ASK TO SPEAK TO YOUR ATTORNEY AND THINK TWICE BEFORE SIGNING ANYTHING

Don't sign forms you don't understand or don't want to sign. You have the right to speak with an attorney.
