

RESOLUTION TO CONDEMN FLORIDA UNIVERSITIES' PARTICIPATION IN THE 287(g) AGREEMENT WITH ICE

WHEREAS, the mission of the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) is to advance the economic condition, educational attainment, political influence, housing, health, and civil rights of the Hispanic population of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the 287(g) program undermines trust between law enforcement and immigrant communities, fosters racial profiling, and creates barriers to education for Latino students and families; and

WHEREAS, universities participating in 287(g) agreements violate principles of civil rights, fairness, and justice by aligning campus police with federal immigration enforcement, endangering undocumented students and families; and

WHEREAS, LULAC has consistently opposed policies that target immigrant communities, separate families, or deny access to education;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) hereby:

- 1. Condemns the participation of Florida universities in the 287(g) program and demands the immediate termination of all such agreements.
- 2. Urges LULAC members, councils, and allies to publicly support universities and colleges that refuse to participate in 287(g) agreements and advocate for sanctuary campus policies.
- 3. Calls on LULAC National to formally endorse LULAC Florida's condemnation of 287(g) and collaborate with civil rights organizations to oppose these partnerships.
