





Thomas Schelling Segregation Model




- ■IN MANY (AMERICAN) CITIES, RACES SEGREGATE.
- THIS HAS UNWANTED CONSEQUENCES.
- WHY DOES THIS HAPPEN, AND WHAT CAN WE DO ABOUT IT?

Main Idea

This is not entirely because people don't like each other. If this were true, high-tolerance cities would have lower segregation than low-tolerance cities, but...empirically this does not hold.

THE PATTERN OF SEGREGATION IS SIMILAR IN CITIES AND WORKPLACES

- Both residential and workplace segregation are in some cases caused by slight preferences for people to which we have a connection.
- Explicit racial discrimination and prejudice are not necessary to create segregation or racial clustering.
- Small unintentional acts of exclusion can create organizations that can seem unfair, exclusionary, and less inclusive.




The central challenge is a Lack of Connection due to our misunderstanding of race






Yali's Question


- Jared Diamond argues that environmental differences rather than inherent differences between races are responsible for some cultures becoming dominant in the modern world.

BACON'S REBELLION 1676

- Multi racial militia led by Francis
 Bacon
- Attacked and burned Jamestown Va to the ground
- Initiated the division of poor whites from nonwhites thereby creating the modern age of racialism
- The laws introduced were called "Color Codes" and made it against the law for nonwhites to intermingle with white

The girls on the left are fraternal twins. They have the same mom and dad...

On average people with a skin tone similar to or darker to the child on the right are:

- Likely to earn less income over their lifetime
- · More likely to die during childbirth
- Less likely to own their house
- More likely to have student debt
- Less likely to be assigned to a gifted class
- More likely to be denied a housing loan
- More likely to be arrested for smoking weed
- More likely to be followed in a store
- Less likely to get a call back for job interview
- Two and a half times more likely to be fatally shot by police
- Less likely to be a lead actor in a big budget movie
- Less likely to have a mentor at work or at college
