New Membership Voting Preparedness Requirement

WHEREAS, the LULAC code calls for LULAC members to respect and preserve their citizenship; honor their country, maintain its tradition in the spirit of its citizens and embody themselves into its culture and civilization, and

WHEREAS, the LULAC code calls for LULAC members to be proud of their origin and maintain it immaculately respect their glorious past and help to defend the rights of all the people, and

WHEREAS, the LULAC code calls for its members to discharge their duties before learning how to assert their rights; educate and make themselves worthy, and stand high in the light of their own deeds; they must be loyal and courageous, and

WHEREAS, the LULAC code asks its members to be optimistic, make themselves sociable, upright, judicious, and above all be sober and collected in their habits, cautious in their actions, and sparing in their speech, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT henceforth new LULAC members of district III receive parliamentary procedures training made available by the LULAC district during their first six months after joining so that they become well versed on the LULAC code, their role and responsibilities before exercising their right to vote at LULAC activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT LULAC District III submit this resolution at the LULAC state and national conventions.
