RESOLUTION ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

WHEREAS, the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) is this nation's oldest and largest Latino organization, founded in Corpus Christi, Texas on February 17, 1929; and

WHEREAS, LULAC throughout its history has committed itself to the principles that Latinos have equal access to opportunities in employment, education, housing and healthcare; and

WHEREAS, LULAC agrees every child deserves a quality education at all levels in every State; and

WHEREAS, many factors can contribute to domestic violence, but none excuse hurting another person. And the roots of domestic violence and other types of violent relationships are linked to power and control; and;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Texas LULAC agrees to collaborate with National LULAC to support any and all assistance for domestic violence initiatives.
