WHEREAS, Texas law requires parents to wait until a campus has failed five consecutive years before they can petition for corrective action, and

WHEREAS, Amending the current law to empower parent to petition for corrective action after two years of campus failure, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the League of United Latin American Citizens supports parent of students to be fully engaged in resolving failing community schools.
