Resolution to Repeal False ID Crimes

Whereas, America is a country of immigrants having been established whose constitution grants the pursuit of happiness with liberty and justice for *all*; and

Whereas, since its inception, LULAC National has vigorously addressed the issues of immigration and human rights; and

Whereas, LULAC National adopted the "Commitment to America" as its national policy to counter abuses to citizens and immigrants; promote access to quality education and opportunity to ensure increased participation in the American way of life; and

Whereas, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (US DHS) has classified all fraud based crimes including using fake social security numbers as "Crimes Involving Moral Turpitude" (CIMT) as a way to deport undocumented immigrants and permanently depriving them of their ability to make a livelihood and support their family.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that LULAC National opposes the US DHS classifying social security identification fraud by undocumented individuals, for the purpose of job opportunities, as a substantial reason for deportation under the CIMT category.
