LULAC Resolution to Request U.S. Department of Justice Investigate the Disparate Distribution of Polling Place in Maricopa County during the 2016 Arizona Presidential Preference Election

Whereas, Maricopa County officials approved a plan that would cut polling locations by 85% compared to the 2008 Arizona presidential preference election (and 70% percent compared to the lower-turnout 2012 Arizona presidential election), and distribute fewer polling locations to parts of Maricopa County with higher minority populations, and;

Whereas, it is an unacceptable disparate distribution of polling locations;

Be it Therefore resolved that, LULAC National respectfully requests that the U.S. Department of Justice investigate what took place in the 2016 Maricopa County Arizona presidential preference election to ensure all voters are treated equally under the law.
