## SUPPORT OF A VETERANS AFFAIRS FULL SERVICE 24/7 HOSPITAL IN THE RIO GRANDE VALLEY, TEXAS

**WHEREAS,** the Department of Veterans Affairs 0/A) estimates that more than 100,000 veterans reside in Deep South Texas, which have always been among the first to answer our country's call. In time of war; and

**WHEREAS,** the current and future health care needs of veterans residing in the deep South Texas area are not being completely met by the Veterans Administration; and

**WHEREAS,** VA officials insist that our veterans do not merit a VA Hospital in the Rio Grande Valley; and

**WHEREAS,** because of the efforts of all veterans' organizations united and the support of elected officials at all levels of government of the Rio Grande Valley, veterans now have the "Valley-Costal Bend Health Care System," independent of the San Antonio HealthCare System; and

**WHEREAS,** the citizens of the great State of Texas voted in favor of proposition 8, that provides money and/or land to the Veterans' Administration to construct a Veterans Hospital in the Rio Grande Valley; and

**WHEREAS,** the veterans community has the utmost faith that our South Texas Legislative delegation in Austin, TX has the best interests of veterans at heart; and

**WHEREAS,** the Rio Grande Valley has witnessed the birth of the University of Texas - Rio Grande Valley, with a School of Medicine; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that LULAC National now calls on our Texas Legislative Delegation to include in their legislative agenda a joint resolution that calls for the great State of Texas to provide for its veterans what the VA has failed to provide, that is, to authorize construction of a Veterans Hospital in the Rio Grande Valley, in partnership with the University of Texas - Rio Grande Valley School of Medicine.
