RESOLUTION TO REQUIRE DUE PROCESS FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS

WHEREAS, resolution to require ICE and other Federal Agencies to follow, uphold, and respect the Due Process of all individuals who are in their custody; and

WHEREAS, the Federal and State law enforcement agencies detain individuals in the course of their business; and

WHEREAS, all individuals have human and civil rights guaranteed to them by our United States constitution; and

WHEREAS, all human beings are members of families and are rooted in their communities; and

WHEREAS, the United States has long claimed to be the land for second chances, a land that calls out to the world to “give me your poor, your huddled masses yearning to be free”; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that LULAC District III, its members and officers require all law enforcement agencies, but especially the Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Agency, to ensure that all individuals in their custody are afforded a proper Due Process and their Constitutional Rights respected.
