WHEREAS, LULAC expects nothing less from those in positions of power, elected or otherwise, than to be treated with respect and dignity, and this includes the President and Commander in Chief of this great country; and

WHEREAS, our Commander in Chief, the President of these United States of America has literally gone out of his way to disregard the high standards of his office by making insulting and hurtful remarks against various groups to include Hispanics, African Americans, women, Veterans, those with special needs, Muslims, our Prisoners of War, Gold Star Families, and the media; and

WHEREAS, as of this date, the President continues to exhibit insensitivity, lack of decorum, and a pattern of childish behavior unbecoming of someone who holds the most powerful position in the country and leader of the free world; and

WHEREAS, the situation pertaining to the President's childish antics has reached a point where now members of his own political party are condemning his antics; and

WHEREAS, LULAC Concilio Zapatista sent the then President-elect a registered letter asking him to apologize to those to whom he had been so offensive yet never received a reply; and

WHEREAS, the negative behavior of the Commander in Chief has taken a major part of the daily media coverage with his constant reckless tweets which take away from the all too important issues that affect our communities and our country; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that LULAC National demands the President of the United States change the course of his actions to a more sensitive and responsible posture towards those he is supposed to serve and represent; that he also stops sending tweets that can only be interpreted as full of hate, causing discord and divisiveness that leads people to push back and act in very undesirable ways; and

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that LULAC National calls on both major parties to take a strong stance, which they have not to this point, and confront the President with any and all appropriate actions to make him stop his reckless behavior that is a threat to our democracy, and is most unbecoming and lacking the dignity of the Office of the Presidency of the United States of America.
