RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A FULL AND COMPLETE INVESTIGATION OF THE FATAL SHOOTING OF CLAUDIA PATRICIA GOMEZ GONZALEZ BY BORDER PATROL

WHEREAS, Congress has defaulted on addressing the issue of immigration; and

WHEREAS, immigrants' contribution to the economy is critical to agriculture, the housing industry, the meat-packing industry, the service industry, etc.; and

WHEREAS, immigrants are law-abiding members of our communities, deserving of basic human rights.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a full investigation must occur into the fatal shooting of Claudia Patricia Gomez Gonzalez, a 20 year old Guatemalan immigrant who was here to continue her education, and that the Border Patrol Agent be held responsible under the law, and;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, as agencies under the auspices of the United States Department of Homeland Security, be held accountable to the law of the land in all instances when interacting with immigrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC), the oldest and largest civil rights organization for the Latino community, demands accountability for the treatment of immigrants as humans deserving of respect under the law and in accordance with common human decency.
