RESOLUTION TO MAINTAIN TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE STATUS (TPS) AND THE DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS (DACA) POLICIES

WHEREAS, LULAC is our Nation's oldest, largest, and most respected Hispano/Latino civil rights organization, established in 1929. Our mission is to seek the advancement of Hispanic Americans in the areas of education, employment, and civil rights; and

WHEREAS, LULAC members have developed a strong track record of success advancing the economic condition, educational attainment, political influence, health and civil rights of the entire population of the United States; and

WHEREAS, LULAC has embraced a legislative platform that promotes humanitarian relief for citizens and immigrants, increased educational opportunities for our youth, and promoted equal treatment for all in the United States and its territories; and

WHEREAS, the years 2017 and 2018 have brought major setbacks to civil, social, and human rights protections in the U.S., especially for immigrants and refugees of color which include DACA Recipients whose country of residence has been the USA for most of their lives;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Arizona LULAC supports Amnesty International USA's <u>I WELCOME</u> initiative and will join the AIUSA Arizona Chapters in their grassroots campaign to encourage municipal and regional leaders to join our efforts to maintain the Temporary Protective Status Resolution (TPS) passed by Congress in 1990 as well as the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) policy enacted by President Obama in 2012 and rescinded in September 2017 by the current Administration.
