RESOLUTION TO RESTORE MEMBERSHIP AND SENIORITY OF MEMBERS EXPELLED FROM LULAC

WHEREAS, LULAC is our Nation's oldest, largest, and most respected Hispano/Latino civil rights organization, established in 1929. Our mission is to seek the advancement of Hispanic Americans in the areas of education, employment, and civil rights; and

WHEREAS, in past LULAC administrations it became a common practice to expel honest and outstanding members of this organizations without due process; and

WHEREAS, there is an atmosphere of institutional racism in the State of Texas where the community needs the representation of those LULAC leaders; and

WHEREAS, those LULAC members have been deprived of their capacity to lead our organization and the community that LULAC represents; and

WHEREAS, these practices of internalized discrimination needs to be eliminated from our organization; and

WHEREAS, these members have been permanently deprived of their LULAC membership and seniority; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the new National President of LULAC along with the executive board start working immediately to process the restoration of membership and seniority of those expelled members on a case by case basis.
