RESOLUTION TO COMBAT JOBLESSNESS AMONG LATINO JOBLESS YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS

INTRODUCED BY LULAC COUNCIL 5294

WHEREAS, there are over 4.5 million youth and young adults (16-24) that are jobless and out of school across the country.

WHEREAS, There are 1,157,304 Latino youth and young adults out of school and jobless.

WHEREAS, There are decades of research on successful programs providing out of school and jobless youth a way to earn a high school diploma and their first jobs.

AND WHEREAS,

1. This will help youth gain job-readiness and employment experience through community based organizations. With this experience youth will be able to work successfully in private sector employment.
2. This program will reduce violence by bringing youth off the streets.
3. Help business reduce their labor shortages.
4. Provide youth a key first step through employment to become successful adults

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That LULAC National commit to lobbying Congress and other Federal Government Agencies to restart a \$5 billion summer and year-round youth employment program this would serve over 1.1 million Latino, 1 million Black and 1.9 million White out of school and jobless youth.
