LEAGUE OF UNITED LATIN AMERICAN CITIZENS DAY 90TH ANNIVERSARY

FEBRUARY 17, 2019

WHEREAS, today, the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) celebrates its 90th Anniversary; and

WHEREAS, since its inception on February 17, 1929, LULAC has championed equal access to education, employment, economic development and civil rights for Hispanic Americans; and

WHEREAS, LULAC has established a comprehensive set of national programs to foster educational attainment, job training, housing, scholarships, citizenship and voter registration; and

WHEREAS, LULAC has adopted a legislative platform that promotes humanitarian relief for citizens and immigrants, increased educational opportunities for youth, and equal treatment for all in the United States; and

WHEREAS, LULAC has become the largest and most successful Hispanic civil rights and service organization in the United States:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THE MAYOR OF WASHINGTON, DC, do hereby proclaim February 17, 2019, in Washington, DC as "LEAGUE OF UNITED LATIN AMERICAN CITIZENS DAY."
