On behalf of the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC), we are pleased to inform you that we will be hosting our 88th annual LULAC National Convention & Exposition in San Antonio, Texas. The activity will take place Tuesday, July 4 through Saturday, July 8, 2017. We invite you to join us!

During the convention, we also look to collaborate with Federal agencies and corporations by connecting with the Greater San Antonio community, especially by reaching out to our future talent. It is for this reason that we are inviting you, your staff and your students to participate in the following activities at ***no cost***.

1. ***Federal Training Institute (FTI) Youth Symposium “Cultivating Talent for Tomorrow “***

The free training will take place Friday, July 5, 2017 (8:00 am – 3:30 pm) at the Henry B. González Convention Center, 900 E. Market St., Room 225D, San Antonio, TX 78205. The key objective of this event is to provide participants with information that may help reduce dropout rates, address current issues that may affect their future, and provide them with motivation and tools to help them continue their education. We know that once students learn more about the endless opportunities to succeed before them, their lives may be changed.

This symposium empowers students with information about diverse opportunities that exist within the federal government (civilian and/or armed forces), while also focusing on the impact that bullying and social media may have while trying to achieve their academic and professional goals. Throughout the day, attendees will interact with representatives from different agencies who will provide guidance regarding scholarships, internships and employment opportunities for current high school students.

In addition to this half -day event, we expect to draw over 10,000 attendees throughout the week. Mark your calendars for July 5-7 and attend the free events open to the public. Some of these events include policy workshops with expert panelists, a career fair, a fun and family-friendly expo hall, and a concert on Saturday July 8, 2017. Entrance to the concert is free for symposium attendees. Students can pick up tickets during the symposium. An adult must accompany all minors.

2. ***LULAC Career Fair***

The career fair will take place on Wednesday, July 5 through Friday, July 7, 2017 at the Expo Hall. The key objective of this event is to highlight participants' skills and potentially help them secure an interview during/after the convention. We invite students to participate in the LULAC Career Fair by uploading their resume at www.lulac.org/jobfair for companies to review candidate resumes in advance and invite those that meet their needs to an on-site interview.
