Who should apply for aid?

Funds will be available for councils in good standing with initiatives focused on addressing issues faced by Latinos experiencing hardship due to COVID-19.

All grants are awarded at the discretion of LULAC Institute Inc.

LULAC Institute Inc. reserves the right to change eligibility requirements at any time based on changing conditions due to need caused by the pandemic and following tax rules.

Who can benefit from this relief project?

LULAC has identified the following priority groups to receive assistance in communities. Although these are identified priorities, we will take all applications and project plans into consideration.

- Individuals who have been displaced from their job due to COVID-19
- Those that work in the service or retail industry
- 55+ age group
- Farmworker Community
- Individuals who do not qualify for an Economic Impact Payment

What type of aid can councils offer?

Projects can address the following needs: general aid, technology, hunger relief, mental health services, mobility, and education.

When will I know if I am awarded?

You should receive an email within 2 to 4 weeks of application submission.

How will funds be sent?

Funds will be sent via gift cards to the address provided in the application and addressed to the council name. Feel free to contact us at relief@LULAC.org if you have been awarded and need to update your address.

Will I need to provide a report after our event?

After your event, LULAC will send all council contacts a template to submit their impact report, which includes a summary of your activity, who you serviced, photos, and a brief financial narrative that must be turned in within two weeks after your event.

When should I expect the funds?

If awarded, gift cards will be disbursed to the councils within two to three weeks of receiving notification of award pending availability of funding. Because this program is funded through donations, there may be times when we will put applicants on a waitlist for available funding and will send the grant funds out as soon as funding is received.
