

COVID Relief - Individual FAQ's

Who should apply for aid?

Funds will be available for individuals who have experienced a decrease in needed wages or loss of job on or after March 10, 2020, that results in a lack of resources to pay for essential expenses; and

Live in the United States or any U.S. territory;

And are over the age of legal majority in their U.S. state or territory; and

All grants are made at the discretion of LULAC Institute

All grants will be made in the LULAC Institutes' sole discretion, and the reserves the right to change eligibility requirements at any time based on changing conditions and following tax rules.

When will I know if I am awarded?

You should receive an email within 2 to 4 weeks of application submission.

How will funds be sent?

Funds will be sent via gift cards to the address provided in the application and addressed directly to the applicant. Feel free to contact us at relief@LULAC.org if you have been awarded and need to update your address.

Will I need to provide my Social Security Number (SSN)?

You do not need to provide a Social Security Number (SSN) to apply.

I am undocumented. Can I apply?

Absolutely!

When should I expect the funds?

If awarded, gift cards will be disbursed to the applicant within two to three weeks of receiving notification of award pending availability of funding. Because this program is funded through donations, there may be times when we will put applicants on a waitlist for available funding and will send the grant funds out as soon as funding is received.
