The **Emerge Latino Conference** is the premier national Latino event convening over 150 young adults from across the country. In addition to the advocacy component of the conference, Emerge attendees are given access to the conference career expo, which offers resume review, interview advice, and various internship, fellowship, and career opportunities. One of the highlights for conference attendees is being able to attend the LULAC National Legislative Conference and Awards Gala, an event that recognizes key leaders who have served the Latino community across the country.

Participants in the program are eligible to enroll in Collegiate LULAC and become part of a nationwide Latino student organization. By joining LULAC, they will have access to policy advocacy briefings, corporate networking opportunities, community service programs, and advocacy campaign training guides.

Emerge Travel Scholarship*

The purpose of the LULAC Emerge Travel Scholarship is to find motivated students who are interested in learning about the current state of affairs of the Latino community in the US, as well as to increase the diversity of students from various Universities attending the conference. The scholarship will provide transportation (flights, train, or gas) and lodging expenses.

LULAC will award

approximately 20 scholarships of up to \$2,000 on the basis of a comprehensive and competitive process. Scholarships will be awarded to college students on a point system, taking into account the following elements: completed application, academic accomplishments, community services, personal essays, resume, and a cover letter.
