After careful consideration on the events related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) crisis and out of an abundance of caution for everyone the 91st LULAC National Convention has been cancelled and moved to 2021. Therefore, all activities under the Federal Training Institute that would have taken place during the LULAC National convention are also cancelled. The cancelled FTI activities are as follows: Plenary Leadership Panel, the Senior Executive and Leadership Development Training, the Speed Mentoring Round Tables, the Youth and Collegiate Symposiums, the Little League Baseball Clinics, and the DoD Excellence in Service Award Ceremony.

LULAC understands that the current situation has caused many Federal agencies to suspend training and/or other leadership development programs. However, we believe, more than ever, that the Federal government leadership and the rest of its workforce needs to represent the population it serves. Therefore, it is critical that we continue motivating and developing a diverse cadre of federal employees to become the next leaders. Leaders, who will understand, address and be sensitive to the needs of all the communities they serve.

In an effort to show our continued support and assist in addressing the aforementioned issues we are partnering with the National Council of Hispanic Employment Program Managers (NCHEPM) and several Federal agencies to ensure we continue developing federal employees by conducting training through the 2020 Virtual Federal Training Institute Partnership (FTIP) Month of Development". This month long event is free of charge to all Federal employees regardless of grade and position as it is the FTIP's goal to develop a diverse pool of leaders for the future.
