



Latina Entrepreneur Academy Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will my organization be responsible for providing the curriculum/content?

A: Yes, grantees are responsible for providing the content for the hours of instruction. LULAC National will provide online resources that can be used to help complement the curriculum.

Q: Will my organization be responsible for confirming speakers/trainers?

A: Yes, grantees will be responsible for inviting and confirming any speakers or trainers that will participate as part of the grantees agenda.

Q: What language should be used while teaching this curriculum?

A: The sessions can be taught in the language that works best for your community. Please note that LULAC will provide participant materials in both Spanish and English.

Q: Do participants need to create an individual business plan or group business plan?

A: Grantee organizations can choose to have participants create their own business plan or submit group business plans. LULAC will provide a template that can be used as a business plan.

Q: What are allowable expenditures?

A: Below is a list of sample expenditures for this program:

- ★ Program Coordinator Stipend
- ★ Printed Materials
- ★ Giveaways/Incentives for Participants
- ★ Venue Fees
- ★ Food for Training Sessions (No alcoholic beverages allowed with LULAC funding)

Q: Are there any restrictions to who can participate?

A: No, women interested in the field no matter their legal status can participate.

Q: How long does the Latina Entrepreneur Academy have to run for?

A: The academy must provide a minimum of 14 hours of instruction. The sessions do not have to be consecutive although recommended. It is highly suggested that sites complete their sessions at least two weeks before reports are due to LULAC National.
